



Spooky Story



There are three elements needed to write your spooky story.

Character - This is the person in your story. Characters have thoughts and feelings, which make them act in certain ways throughout your story.

Setting - This is the location where your story takes place. Think about the setting where your story is taking place. A setting can change the way your character feels. Does it scare them? Does it make them happy? Does it make them act or behave in a certain way?

Plot - This is what your story is about. Think of the plot as the adventure that occurs in your story. What events make the beginning different from the end? Think of your favourite book. How would you describe what it's about to someone else? Apply this thinking to the plot of your own story. A story should have a beginning, middle, and end.

Beginning

Begin your story with an introduction. Start your story by introducing your characters and setting. Who is the story about? Where are they? What are they doing? Set the scene for your reader; help them paint an image of your story in their mind.

You can also use the beginning of the story as a place to write about what challenge might occur for your character.

Middle

The middle of your story is where you write about a challenge or problem your character has to face. What sort of adventure is your character going through? Think about your character and the setting. What issues could your character face that change the direction of your story?

The middle of your story is a great place to write about the actions your character takes when facing this challenge. Be descriptive and imaginative!

End

The end of the last part of your story. Tie up any loose ends in your story.

What challenge or problem did your character face? What actions did they take? Write about how it ends for them.

Give closure to your story. Think about how the story has changed from the beginning.

Endings can be as surprising as you want!



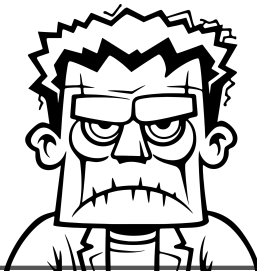
